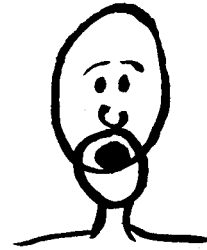
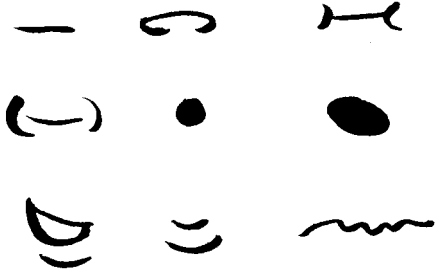


Cartooning Sketch #6

Drawing the cartoon mouth: Cartoon mouths can exhibit expression quicker than any other facial feature. Remember, however, that all features need to work together to effectively get your intended expression across. Teeth, tongues and lips are often not shown. Try cutting a frontal mouth in half to create a profile equivalent. Experiment to find the best style for your character.

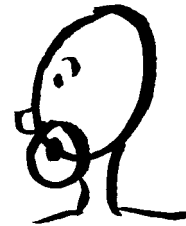
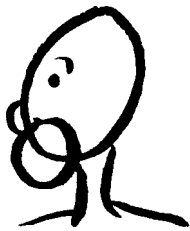


STEP 1

Select a style of cartoon mouth from the samples above.

STEP 2

Draw a frontal cartoon head complete with nose and eyes. Add your cartoon mouth.



STEP 3

Start with a profile cartoon head and add your favorite cartoon nose and eyes.

STEP 4

Draw your cartoon mouth in the same style as your frontal head. You may need to alter them slightly.

STEP 5

Borrow a style of mouth from an existing cartoon character. Draw another **frontal** cartoon head complete with nose and eyes and add your borrowed mouth. Draw another **frontal** cartoon head with nose and add a style of mouth of your own design. Draw a **profile** version of your new cartoon head.
